Description: Neurobiological studies on brain development are guiding researchers to new intervention strategies helpful for ALL families to become more nurturing and children to become more resilient, especially impacting children's future mental health and substance abuse. Dr. Goldsmith's lecture will illustrate the impact of stress on children that results in neurochemical changes in the brain. This workshop will focus on providing participants with effective intervention strategies and will discuss how to

- assist parents and caregivers to mediate neural impact
- treat or repair caregiver-child attachment
- help caregivers become more emotionally attuned to their children.

Discussions will include how to use intervention strategies in various circumstances e.g., temper tantrums, use of "time-ins" rather than "time-outs", children's reactions to stressors such as earthquakes, divorce or deaths of relatives.
