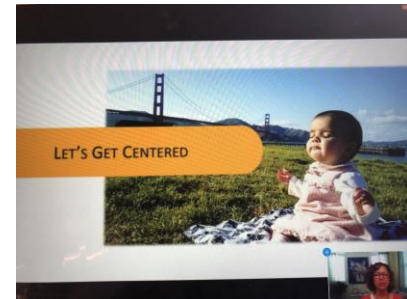

Updates from *Celebrating Families!* Sites:

- Online training is scheduled for March 10-12, 2021 for our two new California Office of Child Abuse Prevention Sites:
 - **CAHELP:** a consortium of 16 school districts and charter schools centered in the High Desert County Region of San Bernardino County) focused on what is best for the child and those who interact with the child.

- **WEAVE:** Sacramento County's primary provider of Domestic Violence and sex trafficking services and its sole rape crisis center with strong community partnerships.
- **Mother Cabrini Health Foundation** awarded \$125,000 grant to Crouse Health to support and expand services for its substance use disorders treatment program. Grant includes adding more counselor hours to *Celebrating Families!*
- **St. Joseph's Addiction Treatment & Recovery Centers** provides a continuum of care with locations in five New York State counties. They will be trained in mid-March to provide *CF!* as part of their Inpatient program and to pilot the new *CF!* Adolescent supplement.
